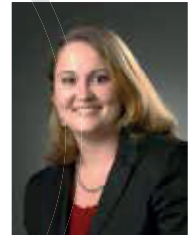

We broadcast and share interesting positions (job, Ph.D, internship, etc) that may fit your professional expectations.



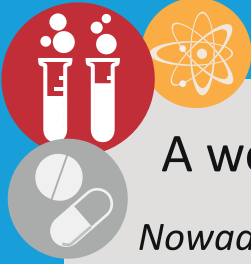
External Interventions
